



Treatment Notes for Household/Tenants

We use the safest chemicals available for all timber treatments. However, certain precautions must be taken before and after we apply any chemicals. We request that our clients read the following information and complete the declaration prior to us carrying out the treatment works.

Before Spraying (the following apply to all rooms being treated and adjacent rooms)

1. All unpackaged foods (fruit, vegetables, etc) to be removed or covered.
2. Pet feeding bowls to be removed and placed in a closed cupboard.
3. All crockery, cutlery, cooking pans and utensils to be put in cupboards. Sinks to be emptied. Kettles to be removed. Kitchen worktops should be cleared.
4. Toothbrushes to be removed and placed in a closed cupboard.
5. All internal doors to be kept closed during the treatment and for a minimum of 1 hour afterwards.
6. It will be necessary for the property to be vacated for the duration of the treatment.

After Treatment

1. Re-entry times should be observed with no room being entered within an hour after treatment. If the floor has been treated, it should be allowed to dry out before it is walked on (times vary depending on conditions).
2. Pets should be kept out of treated rooms for 12 hours minimum.
3. Windows and doors can be opened to help disperse smells and assist drying times.
4. All surfaces used for food preparation should be washed down using your normal household cleaning product.
5. Any crockery, cutlery or food utensil you suspect treatment chemical may have come in contact with should be washed prior to use.
6. Attic areas should not be entered for 48 Hours due to the lack of ventilation.

Please note that our timber treatment chemicals are non-hazardous if used correctly and are only harmful to health in it's fluid state if swallowed. It can also be a skin irritant. Provided the above guidelines are followed, the chemical is extremely safe with no after effects to the occupants of the premises.
